



How to Use “Get to Know Home Fire Sprinklers”

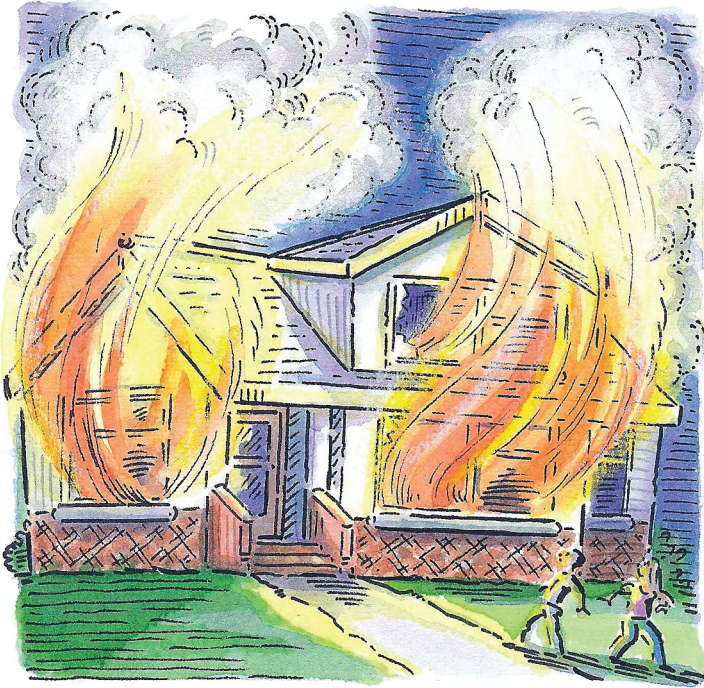
This home fire sprinkler flyer was developed to be used by both adults and children. This piece uses many illustrations and easy-to-read language to teach people about home fire sprinklers.

Make copies to hand out to residents.

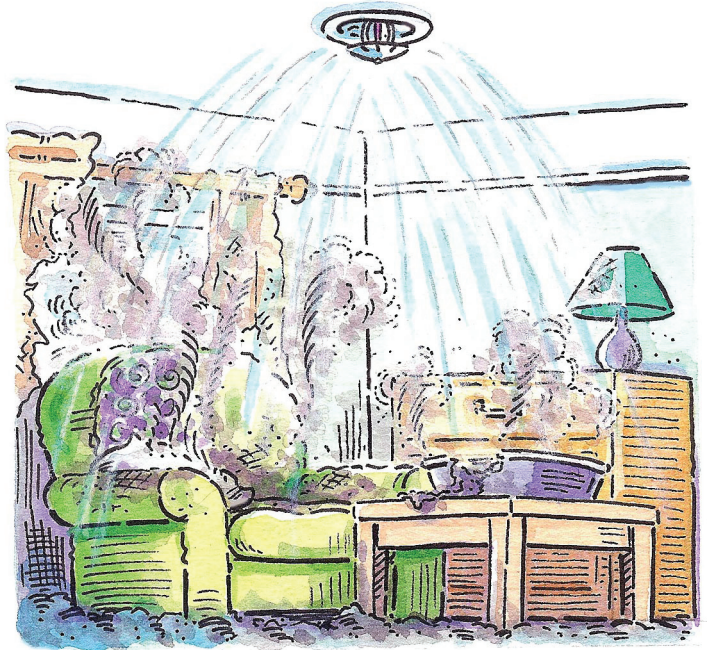


Get to Know Home Fire Sprinklers

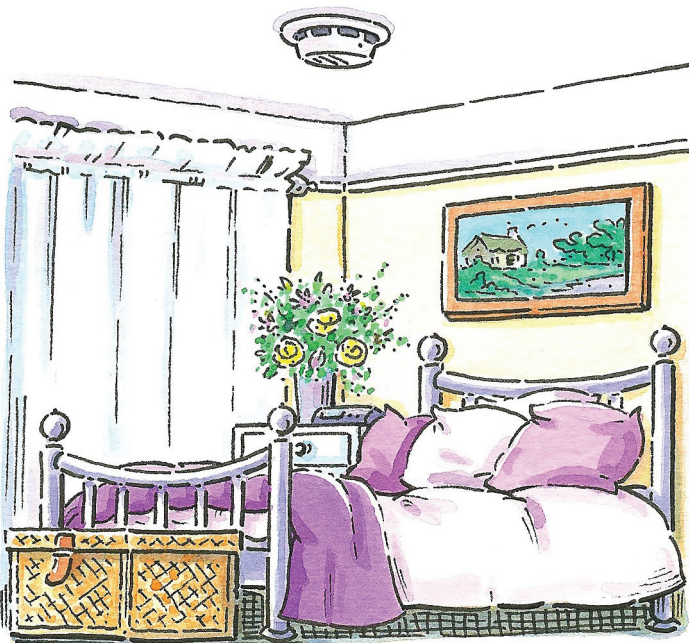
Home fire sprinklers will protect your home from fire.



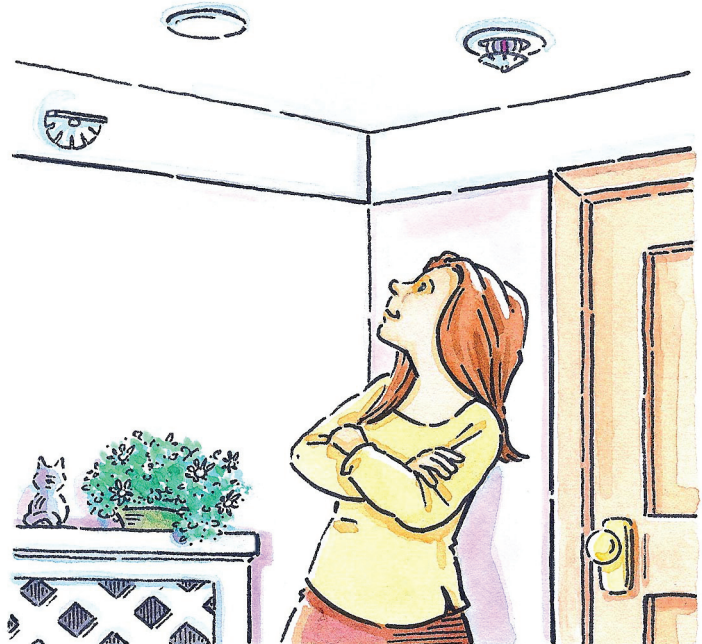
Sprinklers keep a fire small and can put it out.

Sprinklers are small and can be on the ceiling or wall.



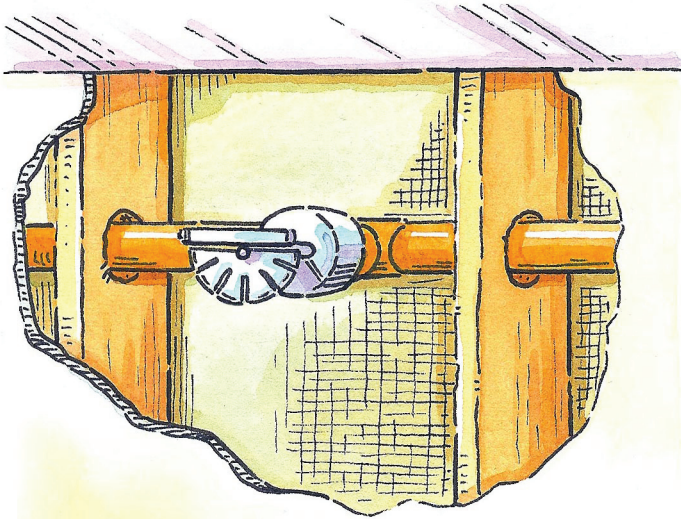

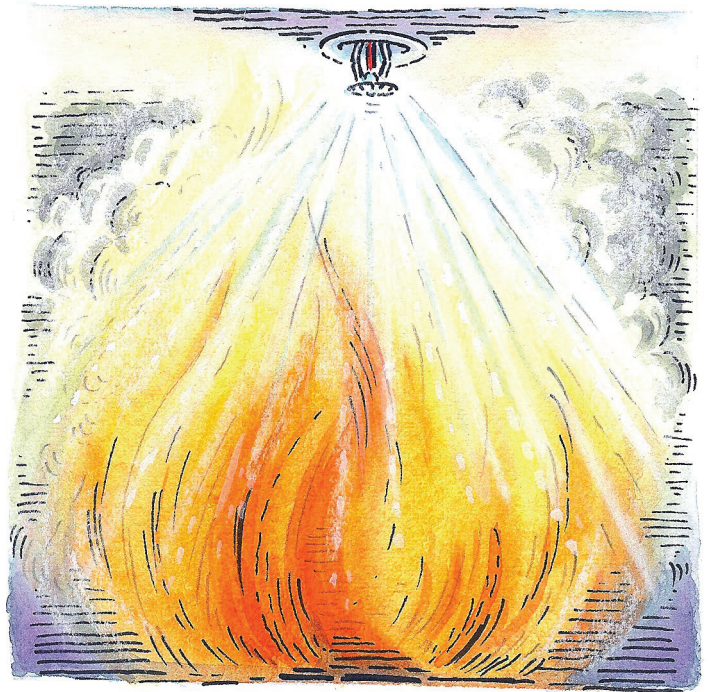


Get to Know Home Fire Sprinklers

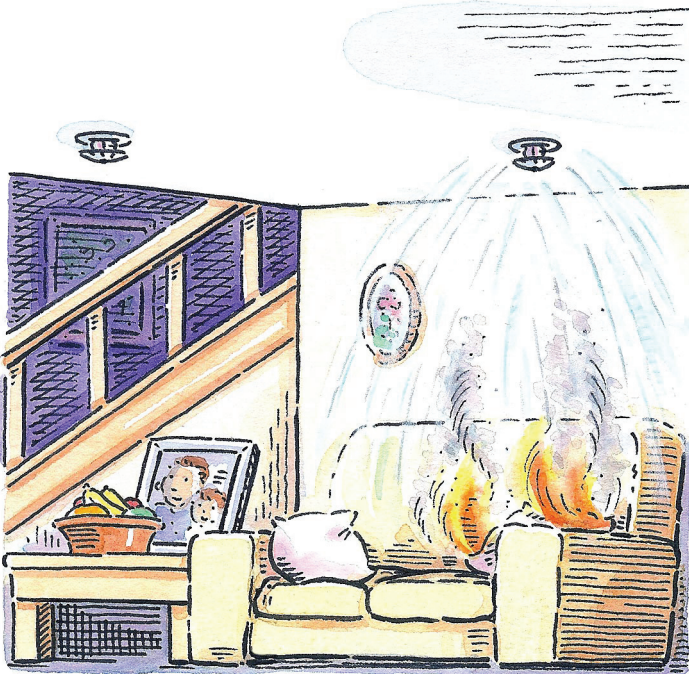
Pipes behind the walls and ceiling are filled with water.



The heat from a fire makes the sprinkler spray water.



Only the sprinkler near the fire will spray water.
